***What is the orchestra?**

The Tennessee Fiddle Orchestra is essentially a chamber orchestra that performs traditional folk music. The TFO explores the rich traditions of fiddle tunes and folk songs which embody the experience of the rural Southeastern United States. Our concerts normally feature world-class guest soloists.

***Who can join?**

The ensemble consists of fiddles, violas, cellos, string basses, mandolins, guitars, flutes, oboes, clarinets, bassoons, saxophones, trumpets, trombones, French horns, and tubas. Anyone of any experience level is encouraged to participate! If you have the desire to be a part of the Tennessee Fiddle Orchestra, there will be a place for you!

***What is the cost?**

The fee is \$90.00 per person per ten-week session.

***What do you need to bring?**

You will need your instrument, a music stand, and a pencil. Music will be provided.
